UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

The petitioner, who was initially accused in a case for the offences punishable under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code (hereinafter called "the IPC") and Section 174 of the Code of

Criminal Procedure subsequently altered to Section 306 of IPC. Now presently he approached this Court only in a case for the offences punishable under Section 306 of the IPC and seeking anticipatory bail before this Court.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 18.10.2024, we had asked the petitioner to file the alleged suicide note and serve the Standing Counsel for the State of Tamil Nadu. Now, the State has filed counter affidavit annexing the alleged suicide note dated 06.01.2024 (vernacular language) along with the translated copy of the same.

Having gone through the said suicide note, we are of the opinion that an interim protection be given to the petitioner.

Accordingly, till the next date of hearing, no coercive measure be taken against the petitioner subject to his cooperation in the ongoing investigation.

The State shall file a detailed affidavit within four weeks. Rejoinder thereto, be filed within four weeks thereafter.
