O R D E R

The petitioner, who was initially accused in a case for offences punishable under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 174 Cr.P.C., but subsequently altered to Section 306 IPC. Presently he approached this Court only in a case for the offences punishable under Section 306 IPC and is seeking anticipatory bail.

His anticipatory bail application was declined by the High Court vide impugned order dated 26.09.2024.

Vide order dated 22.10.2024, interim protection was granted to the petitioner, subject to cooperation in the investigation.

A statement has been made at the Bar today by learned Additional Advocate General Sh. V. Krishnamurthy that the petitioner is cooperating in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, we make the order dated 22.10.2024 absolute.

This would not mean that the petitioner will stop cooperating with the ongoing investigation. The petitioner shall continue to cooperate in the investigation. However, under the circumstances, we are of the opinion that the petitioner is entitled for an anticipatory bail.

In the event of arrest of the petitioner in connection with FIR No. 8/2024 registered at Police Station - Kavandapadi, District Erode, Tamil Nadu, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

In view of above, the Special leave Petition is disposed of.
