O R D E R

In the Writ Petition which is pending before the High Court, the High Court had passed order dated 08.06.2001 permitting the respondents to issue fresh tenders. This order was challenged by the petitioner in Special Leave Petition (C) No.10505 of 2001. Leave was granted in this petition and the appeal was disposed vide order dated 15.11.2002. In the said order it was also made clear that till the time writ petition is decided by the High Court, interim order dated 18.06.2001 passed by this Court staying the order dated 08.06.2001 of the High Court shall remain in operation. It is clear from the above that interim order dated 18.06.2001 was the order whereby the order dated 08.06.2001 of the High Court was stayed permitting the respondents to call for tenders.

It is stated by Mr. Aruneshwar Gupta, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner that the respondents have now issued fresh tenders. It is clearly a different cause of action which has arisen almost after 18 years. It would be open to the petitioner to challenge the said cause of action.

We are of the opinion that no case for contempt is made out.
The contempt petition is accordingly dismissed.
