Heard Mr. S.R. Singh, learned senior counsel along with Mr. Anuvrat Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner.

Considering the submissions raised at the Bar, though we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned judgment and order directing vacation of the premises, we grant the petitioner liberty to remain in occupation till end of June, 2018 and hand over the vacant possession to the landlord on or before that day, subject to payment of occupational charges and clearing the arrears. In case the petitioner or any person in possession of that premises or sub-tenant, if any, does not hand over the possession by the time stipulated herein-above, he shall be liable for contempt of this Court.
