

Ratlam, Madhya Pradesh who may hear the case himself or assign it to a court of competent jurisdiction.

Records of the case would be immediately transferred to the transferee court.

To cut short delay, parties are directed to appear in-person or through an authorized representative or through video-conferencing, if the said facility is available in the transferee court on 13.12.2022. In case there is non-appearance on behalf of the party on the date fixed, court notice would be issued by the transferee court to the defaulting party.

The parties may explore possibility of settlement through mediation. The transferee court would obtain the desire and wishes of the parties and proceed accordingly in this regard.

The transferee court would decide the matter expeditiously.
