UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has been convicted under Section 427 r/w 34 IPC
& Section 307 r/w 34 IPC and has been sentenced to undergo
imprisonment for life. The petitioner has been undergoing sentence
since 26th March, 2014.

The co-accused, Matin Nabib Shaikh, was granted bail by the
High Court by its order dated 19th July, 2018.

It is submitted at the Bar, that the petitioner-accused is
also similarly situated as that of the co-accused, Matin Nabib
Shaikh.

Having regard to the period of sentence of imprisonment which the petitioner has undergone and considering the fact that the co-accused, Matin Nabib Shaikh, has already been granted bail, the sentence of life imprisonment imposed upon the petitioner-Mansoor Nabib Shaikh shall remain suspended and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to execution of bail bonds to the satisfaction of the committal court which shall also be at liberty to impose such appropriate terms and conditions as it may deem necessary.

The special leave petition is accordingly disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
