(i) It would be open to the petitioner to apply for regular bail before the competent court;

(ii) Since Mr Rohit Kumar Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, has stated before the Court that the petitioner has suffered an injury as a result of an accident, we protect the petitioner against coercive steps for a period of four weeks from today within which it would be open to him to pursue his remedies in accordance with law.
