

Mr. N. Venkataraman, learned ASG accepts notice on behalf of Union of India and waives service.

With the consent of both sides, the matter is taken up for disposal today itself.

Our attention has been invited by the learned counsel to the orders dated 05.03.2018, 24.07.2018 and 16.11.2018 passed by this Court, which are appended to the present application.

In keeping with the direction issued in the order dated 16.11.2018, we clarify that the High Court of Judicature of Karnataka at Bengaluru may decide Writ Petition No.12799 of 2014, titled as "Bangalore International Airport Limited v. Union of India & Another", independent of the proceedings pending before the Delhi High Court in Writ Petition (Civil) No.1696 of 2014 and to that extent the earlier order passed by this Court on 05.03.2018 shall stand modified.

We leave it to the parties to make an appropriate application for early disposal of the pending matter before the High Court.

With these observations, Miscellaneous Application No.1349 of 2020 is disposed of.
