O R D E R

We have heard the learned counsel for the parties. In the facts of this case, we are not inclined to interfere with the order of the High Court insofar as it directs that the sister of respondent no. 2/Complainant along with her minor daughters to stay in the house belonging to the petitioners. Since this order was passed on the basis of the statement of petitioner no.2, the High

Court has also observed that the house in question was purchased on the basis of Power of Attorney in which husband of Parminder Kaur (sister of respondent no.2/complainant) has 1/4th share and this is not disputed between the parties. There is no document placed on record in this respect. We leave this question open.

With the aforesaid observations, this special leave petition is dismissed.
