O R D E R

1. Arising out of the judgment, imposing the sentence of three years only for conviction under Section 365/34 of IPC, the present appeal has been filed by the State of NCT of Delhi. It is *inter-alia*, contended that the sentence of three years as awarded by the Trial Court, affirmed by the High Court is inadequate and not sufficient in the facts and circumstances of the case.

2. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material placed before us. Considering the sentence prescribed under Section 365 of IPC in the facts and circumstances of the case, we neither find any good ground to interfere with the impugned judgment or find any sufficient reason to enhance the sentence above 3 years as raised by the

appellant State in the present appeal.

3. Accordingly, the appeal is allowed.

4. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
