Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The application being IA NO. 125993 of 2021 filed by the petitioner for deletion of Respondent No. 4 is allowed, at the risk and cost of the petitioner.

The issues raised in this writ petition are covered by the judgment and order of this Court dated 08.02.2018 in Civil Appeal Nos. 8183-8184/2015 (Union of India & Ors. vs. Radharanjan Pattanaik & Ors.).

The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Union of India submits in fairness that in view of the judgment of this Court, whereby the issues have been decided in favour of the petitioner, the Union of India would not contest this writ petition.

The writ petition is, accordingly, allowed.

The respondent(s) shall pay the pensionary benefits to the members of the petitioner-association. The Union of India shall provide necessary finances to ensure that the petitioners get their pensionary benefits.

The pension payable to the members of the petitioner-association inclusive of the arrears shall be released within four months from the date of communication of this order.

Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
