

Having considered the submissions made on behalf of both the parties, in my opinion the complaint case No. 3611 of 2018, pending before the Court of the 10th Judicial Magistrate First Class, Nagpur (Maharashtra) should be transferred to the Court of Judicial Magistrate, First Class, Indore, Madhya Pradesh as that would serve interest of justice.

So far as examination of witnesses is concerned, considering the prevailing situation arising out of COVID-19 Pandemic, the complainant may apply to the transferee court for conducting examination of the witnesses through Video Conferencing facility.

The Family Court, Nagpur shall send the case record to the transferee Court promptly and without any delay.

The Transfer Petition is allowed in the aforesaid terms.
