- 1) We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties.
- 2) This Court, vide order dated 14.07.2017, directed the parties to approach the Mediator, Supreme Court Mediation Centre for amicable settlement of their disputes.
- 3) As per the Report of the Mediator, the parties have amicably settled their disputes in terms of the Settlement Agreement dated 10.08.2017 entered into and duly signed by them and the same is placed on record.
- 4) Since the parties have already settled their disputes by way of a Settlement Agreement dated 10.08.2017, no order need be passed in these Transfer Petitions except directing the parties to act in the terms thereof.

- 7) However, as prayed and in view of the settlement arrived at, all proceedings between the parties shall stand quashed.

8) In terms of the Settlement Agreement, liberty is granted to the parties to file a joint application, under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 before the concerned Family Court for seeking divorce my mutual consent within a period of four weeks from today and the concerned Family Court shall pass appropriate orders in accordance with law.
