O R D E R

We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

We are happy to record that the matrimonial dispute between the parties has been settled by them. The settlement deed has been brought on record by way of an application duly supported by an affidavit filed by the respondent-husband. The terms of settlement deed are as under :

"1. The FIRST PARTY agree to unconditionally withdrawn all his allegation levelled in his divorce petition mentioned here in above being Petition no. 732 of 2018 pending before the Family Court, Haridwar and consequently shall withdraw the divorce petition and thereupon the SECOND PARTY shall be withdrawing her Transfer Petition No. 548 of 2020 pending before Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and/or both the parties shall be appearing before Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and requesting for

withdrawal of the cases pending before Ld. Family Court: Haridwar, as well the transfer petition pending before Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

2. The FIRST PARTY undertakes to include the names and details of SECOND PARTY and the minor children in the office records so as to include their names in the pension benefits in the pension payment order No. 239032100435 and all related in/concerned benefits so that all the future benefits, if any, shall be enjoyed by SECOND PARTY and the minor children.

3. Both the parties shall make efforts to lead their Matrimonial life in a peaceful manner.

4. It is agreed by both the parties that they shall be making all efforts for proper upbringing of the minor children and shall be properly looking after their welfare and education.

5. This settlement is signed by both the parties after fully understanding the terms and conditions, the meaning and the context thereof and further admit that there has been no force, fraud, coercion, misrepresentation and/or, pressure of any nature whatsoever and they are executing this deed out of their own free will and consent.

6. The terms settled in this deed are irrevocable in nature.

7. Both the parties undertake to lead a peaceful, happy married life with each other. keeping in mind the benefits and welfare of the minor children."

In view of the settlement arrived at between the parties, all the disputes pending between them,

i.e. Divorce Petition bearing Petition No. 732/2018 titled as "Shri Girish Monga vs. Smt. Karunna Monga" pending before the Family Judge, Family Court, Distt. Haridwar Uttarakhand and the present transfer petition pending before this Court shall stand withdrawn.

Both the parties are directed to abide by the terms and conditions arrived at between them strictly. The terms of settlement deed shall form part of this order.
