The instant petition has been filed under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 seeking transfer of Divorce Case M.C. No. 3043/2019 titled Deepak B.H. vs. Pooja Ashok Bobade pending before the court of Principal Family Judge, Bangalore, Karnataka to the Family Court, Latur, Maharashtra.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties and having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court considers it appropriate to allow the transfer petition.

Accordingly, **Divorce Case M.C. No. 3043/2019 titled "Deepak B.H. vs. Pooja Ashok Bobade"** pending before the court of Principal Family Judge, Bangalore, Karnataka is transferred to the Family Court, Latur, Maharashtra.

The matters pending between the parties at Family Court, Latur, Maharashtra be clubbed and be heard together.

Learned Counsel for the respondent submits that he may be permitted to record his statement through video conferencing.

At least, on the date of their first hearing the parties shall record their presence physically and thereafter the parties are at liberty to move an application for seeking permission from the concerned court to record the statement by video conference, if so desired. If such an application is filed, let the competent court may take a call and proceed in accordance with law.

The parties shall record their presence before the Family Court, Latur, Maharashtra on **28.02.2022 at 11.00 a.m.**

The Registry is directed to send the copies of this Order to the concerned courts immediately for compliance.

The transfer petition stands disposed of accordingly.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
