O R D E R

This transfer petition has been filed by the petitioner for transfer of the C.T. Case No.4479 of 2019 filed by the respondent, pending before the Court of learned Chief Metropolitan Magistrate (North-West), Rohini Court Complex, Delhi, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Calcutta.

Heard Mr. Anjani Kumar Mishra, learned counsel for the petitioner.

It appears that same petitioner had also filed the Transfer Petition (Criminal) No.160 of 2020 for transfer of similar kind of proceedings from the Court at Delhi to a competent Court at Calcutta but this Court had dismissed the same vide its order dated 14.05.2020.

I have considered the facts and circumstances of the present case and also the submissions advanced by the learned counsel. Bearing in mind the order passed by this Court in

Transfer Petition (Criminal) No.160 of 2020, this Petition is required to be dismissed as it will not be in the interest of justice to transfer the proceedings from the Court at Delhi to another Court at Calcutta. Ordered accordingly.
