- 1 Mr Amol B Karande, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, submits that while the High Court has permitted the Municipal Corporation to take steps in accordance with law in respect of the allegedly unauthorized construction, it is necessary to grant liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to legal remedies if an adverse order is passed. This is the only submission.

- 2 If any adverse action is taken by the Municipal Corporation in pursuance of the liberty granted by the High Court, the aggrieved individuals will be at liberty to pursue such remedies as are available in law.

- 3 The Special Leave Petition is dismissed, subject to the clarification in para 2 above.
