We see no reason to interfere in the matter. The special leave petition is dismissed.

However, considering the facts and circumstances on record. We extend the period granted by the High Court within which the petitioner was directed to surrender. The petitioner is now granted time till 17.2.2020 to surrender before the Trial Court. Rest of the order dated 7.2.2020 passed by the High Court in Cr1.M.C. No.703/2020 remains intact.

In case, after surrender, the petitioner prefers an application for bail, the same shall be considered as expeditiously as possible.
