O R D E R

The petitioner met with an accident on 10.03.2012 whereby she suffered permanent disability. She has filed claim petition before the Motor Accidents Claim Tribunal at Aurangabad, Maharashtra (for short "the Tribunal") where an award/compensation of Rs.4,10,000/- along with interest of 9% per annum, has been awarded. An appeal was filed against this order by the petitioner where the High Court increased the award/compensation amount to Rs.9,16,000/- along with interest of 9% per annum.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the respondent no.3-insurance company. In spite of service of notice, none appears

on behalf of the respondent nos.1 & 2.

We see no reason to interfere in the order impugned passed by the High Court, in exercise of our jurisdiction under Article 136 of the Constitution of India.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed along with pending application(s), if any.
