O R D E R

The Special Leave Petition stands dismissed. However, the drill of the arbitration clause shall be followed with the following time-lines:

If the petitioner approaches the competent authority within one week from today, the competent authority shall decide the matter within two weeks thereafter.

If an appeal is to be preferred, the said appeal shall be filed within one week from the date on which the aforesaid decision of the competent authority is communicated to the parties and the appellate authority will then decide the matter within three weeks thereafter.

After the appellate authority decides, if an appeal is preferred to the Tribunal, the Tribunal will take up and dispose of the said appeal within a period of 9 months.

The Special Leave Petition stands disposed of.
