This transfer petition has been filed by the petitioner - wife for transfer of Divorce Petition being O.S. No.631 of 2019 titled "Rakesh Mathur Vs. Smt. Aaradhna Mathur" from the Family Court, Ranchi to a Court of competent and like jurisdiction at Ghaziabad, U.P.
