In terms of the signed reportable judgment, the Court concluded as follows:

"For the aforesaid reasons the appeals filed in Criminal Appeal Nos.300-301 of 2018 and Criminal Appeal Nos.298-299 of 2018 are allowed and conviction recorded and sentence imposed upon the appellants therein is set aside. They shall be released forthwith if their custody is not required for any other case. Criminal Appeal Nos.1416-1417 of 2017 and Criminal Appeal No.1418-1419 of 2017 filed by Ishwari Lal Yadav and Kiran Bai respectively are partly allowed, setting aside the conviction recorded and sentence imposed for the offence under Section 364/34 and 120B of the IPC. However, their conviction under Section 302/34 and 201, IPC is confirmed, confirming the death sentence imposed on them for the offence under Section 302/34 IPC. The sentence imposed on them under Section 201 IPC is also confirmed."

In terms of the signed reportable judgment, the Court held as follows:

"For the aforesaid reasons, this Criminal Appeal is partly allowed, setting aside the conviction recorded and sentence imposed for the offence under Sections 364/34 read with 120B IPC. However, we confirm the conviction recorded and sentence imposed for the offence under Sections 302/34 and Section 201 IPC."
