O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

Having heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and carefully perusing the material available on record, we see no reason to interfere with the impugned order passed by the High Court granting bail to the petitioner, subject to the condition that he shall deposit a sum of Rs.50,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty Lakhs only) and furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs only) with two sureties of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) each.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that due to Covid-19 situation prevailing in the

country, he wants time to deposit the payment of Rs.50,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty Lakhs only), as ordered by the High Court, by way of installments.

We feel that the petitioner can make such a request to the High Court.

We hope and trust that the High Court will consider such a request of the petitioner.

With the above observation, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.

Pending application filed in the matter also stands disposed of.
