O R D E R

1. The impugned order of the High Court of Bombay has fixed 2<sup>nd</sup> January, 2025 for final hearing of the writ petition<sup>1</sup> of the petitioner. 2024, the High Court may consider the desirability of granting such interim relief considered appropriate by it on facts and in the circumstances.
