O R D E R

Delay condoned.

There is a broad consensus between learned counsel for the respective parties that the petitioners shall pay a further sum of Rs.2,25,000/- as full and final settlement of the claim of the respondent No.1 - teacher against the petitioners with respect to the claim of backwages.

Mr. R. Basant, learned senior counsel has stated at the Bar that the petitioners shall deposit in the Bank Account of the respondent No.1 - teacher a further sum of Rs.2,25,000/- within a period of four weeks from today, the particulars of which shall be furnished to the petitioners by the respondent.

On deposit of the said amount, there shall not be any claim of the respondent - teacher against the petitioners with respect to the claim of the backwages etc. and the same shall be the full and final settlement of respondent No.1 against the petitioners.

The special leave petitions stand disposed of accordingly.

Pending applications stand disposed of.
