O R D E R

Having heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and carefully perusing the material available on record, we see no reason to interfere with the impugned orders passed by the High Court.

During the course of hearing, it is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioners that similarly placed persons who approached the Bihar State Sunni Waqf Board got alternative sites to run their garages and, therefore, they would also want to approach the said Waqf Board for alternative land(s) for their livelihood.

We are not sure and aware whether such lands are available or not.

However, if any such application is made by the petitioners, it is left to the said Waqf Board to consider the same on its own merits and in accordance with law, preferably within a period of three months from the date of communication of this order.

With the above observation, the Special Leave Petitions are disposed of.
