Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the nature of the order which we propose to pass, we dispose of the special leave petition without issuing notice to the respondent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, we dispose of the special leave petition with the direction that in case the petitioner deposits a sum of Rs.7 lakhs with the Family Court, Saket, within a period of four weeks from today, and produce receipt of the same before the High

Court in MAT APP. (F.C.) No. 160/2020, the High Court shall then proceed to hear the matter in appeal on merits.

The amount so deposited by the petitioner before the Family Court shall be permitted to be withdrawn by the respondent without furnishing any security, which shall be subject to and adjusted with the final order regarding maintenance, which the Court may pass on merits of the case.
