UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

The dispute in the present matter was resolved vide order dated 18.01.2021 whereby an amount of Rs.1,09,08,106/- was directed to be deposited by the appellants/applicants with the Registry of

this Court. In the last paragraph of the said order it has been observed as under:

"Liberty is reserved to the respondents to withdraw the amount and if there is any dispute in relation to the calculation of interest, respondents are free to inform the learned senior counsel for the appellants. If the grievance of the respondents still persists and not redressed, liberty is reserved to move this Court."

It is not disputed that the amount of Rs.1,09,08,106/- has been deposited by the appellants with the Registry of this Court which is lying with the Registry.

Mr. Rakesh Kumar Khanna, learned senior counsel appearing for the appellants/applicants has submitted that there was some discrepancy in the calculation of the interest. Hence, according to him an amount of Rs. 13,07,612/- remains to be paid by the appellants/applicants. He seeks permission to deposit the said amount with the Registry. The appellants/applicants are permitted to deposit the said amount within 10 days from today.

Mr. Kuljeet Raval, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents states that the interest amount would be more than what is being now deposited by the appellants/applicants. Though, he had, in compliance of the order dated 18.01.2021, approached the learned senior counsel for the appellants/applicants but the matter could not be resolved. Hence, appellants/applicants seeks indulgence of this Court to decide the matter relating to interest.

Since the order was passed by a Bench presided over by Hon'ble Mr. Justice S. Abdul Nazeer, it would be appropriate that the

matter be placed before the same Bench after obtaining the necessary orders from Hon'ble the Chief Justice of India.
