Learned senior counsel for the respondents also submits that the said respondents have not completed their minimum tenure of service and thus, it is his submission that the said respondents now being away from the place for a few months, it may be appropriate if their request for re-transfer back can be considered.

We permit the respondents to move an appropriate application

in this behalf and on such application being moved, the appellant(s) will consider the applications within a period of two months of the said applications being made.

The appeals are allowed in the aforesaid terms leaving the parties to bear their own costs.
