1) Leave granted.

2) We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties at length.

3) It appears that the High Court, without considering the materials on record and even after raising the substantial question of law, did not take any note of the same proceeded in the matter.

4) On the contrary, the High Court dealt with the matter on the different grounds and came to the conclusion.

5) In our opinion, it is the duty of the High Court first to deal with the issues raised by it in second appeal and thereafter to answer the same.

6) In view of this, we find that the order passed by the High Court cannot be accepted or held sustainable in the eyes of law. Accordingly, the order so passed by the High Court is set aside and we remand the matter to the High Court for hearing the same afresh, after affording an opportunity of hearing to both the

parties.

7) The appeal is disposed of on the above terms.
