The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 25 of the Civil Procedure Code has been filed by the petitioner (wife) for transfer of divorce petition bearing D.O.P. No. 58/2019 titled as "*M.S. Kumar vs. J. Indhumathi*" pending before the Court of Senior Civil Judge, Puttur, Andhra Pradesh to the Court of Principal Subordinate Judge at Chengalpattu, Tamil Nadu.

The marriage between the parties was solemnized on 16<sup>th</sup> June, 2017 and a male child born out of wedlock is presently in custody of petitioner-wife.

As per Office Report dated 25-3-2021, notice on this Transfer Petition was issued to Respondent-husband through Speed Post who has been duly served on 16-6-2020 but no one appears on his behalf and no Vakalatnama has been filed.
