Delay of 83 days in filing Review Petition is condoned.

One Raghurai Ram holding the post of Peon was given the appointment as Clerk and in the resultant vacancy, the petitioner was given temporary appointment to the post of Peon, with a specific condition that in case of reversion of said Raghurai Ram, the appointment of the petitioner would come to an end. Since said Raghurai Ram was reverted to the substantive post of Peon, the service of the petitioner as Peon was terminated. The challenge in that behalf was negated by the High Court and that order was affirmed by this Court while dismissing the Special Leave Petition.

We have gone through the grounds raised in the Review Petition and do not find any error apparent on record to justify interference in review jurisdiction.

This Review Petition is dismissed.
