UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Though the Supreme Court Mediation Centre had forwarded a letter dated 10th January, 2022 stating, inter alia, that the mediation could not succeed, on interacting with learned counsel for the parties, both of them state that if given one more opportunity, there is a likelihood of the parties arriving at a settlement.

2. Accordingly, without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the parties, they are directed to appear before the same Mediator who was appointed earlier by the Supreme Court Mediation Centre.

3. Parties request that they may be permitted to participate in the mediation proceedings virtually. Permission, as prayed for, is granted.

4. Parties shall appear before the learned Mediator on 13th December, 2022 at 4.00 p.m. and any further dates as may be fixed by the learned Mediator.

5. List after six weeks to report settlement, if any.

6. Interim order, if any, shall continue till further orders.
