O R D E R

1. Leave granted.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and respondent No. 3.
3. Both the parties are present in Court. They rely on the settlement arrived at before the Counselor, Family Court, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi, dated 16.03.2016, wherein they have stated that they will abide by the terms of the settlement.
4. Accordingly, we consider it appropriate to quash the FIR which is also referred to in the settlement. Mr. Ashok Vohra, who is

present in Court acknowledges that he has received demand draft in the name of Shruti Vohra for the sum of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs) as contemplated by Clause 4(iii) of the settlement.

5. In view of above, we quash the FIR referred to in the settlement, dated 16.03.2016.

6. The parties may apply for release of the amount lying before the Metropolitan Magistrate, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi.

7. The appeal stands disposed of accordingly.
