The application for impleadment filed by the informant is allowed.

The petitioner was conviction under Section 307 and 323 read with 34 and was sentenced to 7 years

imprisonment. The appeal filed by him is pending consideration in the High Court. The application filed for suspension of sentence was dismissed by the High Court against which this Special Leave Petition is filed.

The petitioner has undergone a sentence of 2 years and about 10 months. Without going into the merits of the matter, we are of the opinion that the petitioner is entitled for suspension of sentence as there is no likelihood of the appeal being decided in the near future.

The petitioner is directed to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The Special Leave Petition is disposed of. Pending application(s), shall also stand disposed of.
