O R D E R

SLP (C) No.7152/2020 & SLP (C) No.7154/2020

The entire factual conspectus leading to the filing of the instant Special Leave Petitions need not be adverted to as in our view the interest of justice would be served if the respondents herein are granted the benefit of regularization in terms of the order dated 12.05.2017 passed by the office of the Executive Engineer, Electricity Distribution Division-First, Madhyanchal Vidyut Vitran Nigam Ltd., Gonda, but the monetary impact of said order shall be restricted to the amount of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs Only) per respondent, which shall be given to the concerned respondents within eight weeks from today.

All the other benefits including the issue pertaining to length of service will be governed by the order dated 12.05.2017.

Subject to the modification indicated hereinabove, we see no reason to interfere in the instant Special Leave Petitions, which are, accordingly, disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.

The respondent Hansraj expired on 07.06.2019.

The aforesaid benefits in the case of deceased respondent Hansraj would, therefore, be limited up to the date of his death and the requisite amounts shall be made over to his legal representatives within eight weeks from today.
