O R D E R

In Sessions Case No.82/2017, on the file of Principal District & Sessions Judge at Mandya, vide Crime No.582/2016 of Maddur Police Station, Mandya District, Karnataka, 20 persons have been arraigned as accused.

Charge-sheet was filed on 25.03.2017 for offences punishable under Sections 143,147,148, 504, 323, 324, 307,

302, 109, 114, 120(B) r/w 149 IPC.

Accused Nos.4-20 are stated to be on bail, while accused Nos.1-3 are still inside.

The present matter arises out of cancellation of bail granted to the petitioner.

We see no reason to interfere in the matter.

However, considering the fact that charge-sheet has already been filed in March, 2017, we direct the trial court to take up the matter for framing of charges, if any. The petitioner will be at liberty to prefer an application for bail after the stage is over.

The special leave petition is dismissed.

Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.

We have not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter which will be gone into by the trial court at appropriate stage.
