We have heard Mr. Arsh Dhanotia, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner. Considering the fact that, in the earlier round of litigation in the year 2012, the order cancelling the income certificate came to be considered by the learned Single Judge further confirmed by the Division Bench of the High Court and thereafter, when the services of the petitioner has been terminated and thereafter, the Writ Petition has been dismissed, we see no reason to interfere with the impugned judgment and order passed by the High Court in exercise of powers under Article 136 of the Constitution of India.
