O R D E R

SLP(C) Nos. 6168-6173/2019 filed at the instance of the State were directed against the judgment and order dated 01.08.2018, the concluding part of which was to the following effect:

"14. In that view of the matter, while upholding the impugned order passed by learned Tribunal, we declare the Amendment Rules, 2001 to be ultra vires of Articles 14 and 16 of the Constitution of India and strike down the same.

The State-Respondents are directed to convene review DPC for the applicants and other eligible officers for promotion to the cadre of Under Secretary as per the provisions of Rules, 1980 in respect of the vacancies of the year 2001 and also for subsequent years and grant all consequential benefits within a period of three months hence."

The conclusions so drawn by the High Court were affirmed by this Court in its order dated 01.10.2020, whereafter certain consequential directions were passed so that the directions passed by the High Court could be effectuated in a time bound manner.

The present contempt petitions allege infraction on part of the official respondents and submit inter alia that the directions so passed against the state of Odisha are not being complied with.

Without going into the merits or demerits of such contentions, we give liberty to the petitioners to approach the High Court of Orissa with appropriate application to ventilate their grievance.

These contempt petitions are disposed of in aforesaid terms.

Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
