O R D E R

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

The petitioners are aggrieved by the order dated 10.02.2021 whereby the High Court has directed the petitioners to vacate the house of the respondent herein by the end of March, 2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that

the time granted by the High Court is very less and in fact, the petitioners herein had requested the High Court to grant 10 months time.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, we are of the opinion that the time prayed for by the petitioners is quite unreasonable. However, considering the COVID 19 situation, we grant four months further time to the petitioners to vacate the premises of the respondent.

Accordingly, we dispose of this special leave petition with the direction that the petitioners shall be permitted to retain the possession of the property in question till 31.07.2021, provided an undertaking is filed by the petitioners before the Registry of this Court within three weeks from today.

Pending applications stand disposed of.
