The appellant, M/s Emgee Infrastructure Holdings (INDIA) Private Limited, raised the plea that the appellate Tribunal was wrong in dismissing the appeal on the ground of limitation.

Even if there is some merit in the aforesaid contention, we are not inclined to examine the plea in detail, for the reason that this is a case of pre-existing dispute. Hence, the appeal is dismissed.

The learned Senior Advocate appearing for the appellant states that the appellant, M/s Emgee Infrastructure Holdings (INDIA) Private Limited, would file a civil suit along with an application under Section 14 of the Limitation Act, 1963. We make no comments either way in this regard.
