**SLP (C) No 10382/2020 & SLP (C) No 10383/2020**

- 1 In the facts and circumstances of the case, we are not inclined to entertain the Special Leave Petitions under Article 136 of the Constitution of India.

- 2 The Special Leave Petitions are accordingly dismissed.
- 3 Pending applications, if any, including the applications for intervention/impleadment stand disposed of.

**WP (C) No 1463/2020, WP (C) No 45/2021 & WP (C) No 491/2021**

- 1 In these Petitions under Article 32 of the Constitution, the petitioners were teachers who have retired from service. They rely upon the judgment of the Division Bench of the High Court dated 27 November 2019.
- 2 The Special Leave Petitions, namely, SLP (C) No 10382/2020 and SLP (C) No 10383/2020 arising out from the judgment of the High Court have been dismissed. Consequently, the petitioners would be entitled to the benefit of the directions contained in the judgment of the High Court. The consequential benefits shall be paid over within a period of two months from the date of this order.
- 3 The Petitions are accordingly disposed of.
- 4 Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
