Delay in refiling the Special Leave Petition is condoned.

Mr. B.S. Rajesh Agrajit, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was sentenced to one year rigorous imprisonment and also ordered to pay fine for his conviction, under Sections 279, 304A and 429, IPC. He then submits that the petitioner has deposited the fine. Since then, the accused has already spent over one year in jail and therefore, this Special Leave Petition has now become infructuous.
