UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

Heard Mr. Ramandeep Singh, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. Karan Sharma, learned Standing Counsel

appearing for the State of Punjab. The respondent No. 2 (complainant) is represented by Mr. Ishkaran Bhandari, learned counsel.

The challenge here is to the order of the High Court dated 13.01.2020 whereby the parties were required to appear before the Sub-Registrar to execute the sale on receipt of balance sum of Rs.57 lakhs from the complainant. The complainant is ready to remit the balance of Rs.57 lakhs but by taking advantage of the interim protection granted to the petitioner, he has not complied with the Court's order although there is no stay of the said order of the High Court dated 13.01.2020.

The petitioner was granted interim protection from arrest till today while notice was issued in this case on 04.03.2020.

Considering the above, we deem it appropriate to recall the order for interim protection. It is also made clear that this Court had not stayed the operation of the impugned order of the High Court.

With the aforesaid, the Special Leave Petition stands dismissed.
