O R D E R

This petition has been filed seeking transfer of the Petition No.-A-1936 of 2019 filed under Section 13(1)(i-a) and Section 10 of the Hindu Marriage Act titled "*Mr. Amit Ajit Thadani vs. Mrs. Manju Amit Thadani*" from the Family Court, Mumbai at Bandra to the Family Court, Shahdol, Madhya Pradesh.

Notice was issued and stay of further proceedings was granted by this Court on 03.03.2020.

As per the Office Report, service is complete and vide order dated 25.03.2021, this Court directed as follows :-

"When the matter was listed on 26th February, 2021, the respondent-in-person did not appear as such the matter was directed to be kept after two weeks so as to enable the respondent-in-person to appear.

Today also the respondent-in-person is not present.

Respondent-in-person is granted four weeks' time, by way of last chance, so as to enable him to appear on the next date of hearing.

It is made clear that in the event the respondent-in-person does not appear on the next date of hearing, the Court would proceed to hear and decide the petition without his presence."

No one appears on behalf of the Repsodent.

Therefore, in view of the order of this Court passed and as per the averments made in the Transfer Petition, this Court has no option but to allow the Transfer Petition and transfer Petition No.-A-1936 of 2019 titled as "*Mr. Amit Ajit Thadani vs. Mrs. Manju Amit Thadani*" pending in the Family Court, Mumbai at Bandra to the Family Court, Shahdol, Madhya Pradesh.

The Transfer Petition is, accordingly, allowed.

A copy of this order be sent to the Court concerned, to do the needful.

Let the records pertaining to Petition No.-A-1936 of 2019 be also transferred forthwith to the concerned Court.

Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
