We are not inclined to entertain the Special Leave Petition under Article 136 of the Constitution since the petitioner had furnished an undertaking to the High Court to

vacate the premises by 31 May 2020. The undertaking has been recorded in the order of the High Court dated 29 November 2019. The Special Leave Petition is accordingly dismissed.

At this stage, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that he may move the High Court for extension of time to vacate the premises purely on humanitarian grounds since twelve hundred students are studying in the school. The High Court may consider any such application on the basis of the facts which are placed before it by the petitioner.
