The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

When the matter was taken up for hearing on 20.05.2020, we directed the learned counsel for the petitioner to take instructions whether the petitioner was ready to deposit some amount of money, relating to the cheques which were dishonoured, to allow him to cross-examine P.W-1.
