UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and carefully perused the material placed on record.
2. The predecessor of the petitioners - late Het Ram admittedly sold land ad-measuring 13 kanals 15 marlas vide Sale Deed dated 17.10.1985. Since on measurement, the area of the land described in the Sale Deed was found to be less than 13 kanals 15 marlas, late Het Ram made the deficiency good and gave possession of a small area measuring 14 marlas out of some other khasra number to the respondent - vendees. It is in this backdrop that the possession of the respondents over the land in dispute has been

concurrently upheld by the Courts below.

3. In view of the above, no case to interfere with the impugned judgment dated 15.01.2020 is made out.

4. The Special Leave Petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
