O R D E R

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioners. Though there is a delay of 205 days in filing the restoration application a delay of 821 days in re-filing the Special Leave Petition. Nonetheless, we allow the application for restoration.

M.A. No. 327 of 2021 stands disposed of.

Coming to the merits of the matter, the petitioners applied under the 'Voluntary Retirement Scheme' in February, 1995. Acceptance was communicated on 8th March, 1995. The monetary benefits of 'Voluntary Retirement

Scheme' were made available and accepted by the petitioners. Thereafter, in 1998 they filed a writ petition claiming that they were coerced into the accepting the 'Voluntary Retirement Scheme' by the management.

In the circumstances, we find no reason to interfere with the impugned order. The special leave petition is dismissed.
