This Court on 11.02.2021 while disposing of the special leave petition granted interim bail to the petitioner for a period of six weeks. The petitioner was directed to surrender after the expiry of the said six weeks' period i.e. 25th March, 2021 before the concerned Jail Authorities without fail.

Now, the petitioner has filed M.A.No.509/2021 in SLP(Cr1.)No.5020/2020 seeking extension of the period of interim bail for a period of six months on medical ground.

Having heard learned senior counsel for the petitioner and carefully perusing the averments made in the application for extension of time for surrendering, we grant one week's more time

from today to the petitioner to surrender before the concerned jail authorities, failing which the police is at liberty to take him into custody.

IA No. 41424/2021 stands disposed of accordingly.

As a sequel to the above, MA No.509/2021 also stands disposed of.
